First things first, this game will play on Windows 10 even though it was originally released in 2008. This is a classic time management game that has the player completing various tasks before the timer runs out for the level. No, at its heart Jane's Realty is a time management, and one that demands a frenzy of clicking at that. There is no relaxed mode or carrying on with a level if the time

runs out. The player has to complete various goals while keeping track of tenet happiness and random events that necessitate a clean up or repair order. It starts out slowly enough that learning the gameplay is easy enough, but I soon found out that this is a game that doesn't really like the concept of downtime or taking a moment to breath. Think and work fast! I didn't play more than an hour when I wrote this review, so I don't know about all the issues that might crop up. I did encounter a situation where I one of my goals was to upgrade a house, and getting the ability to do so was difficult.
